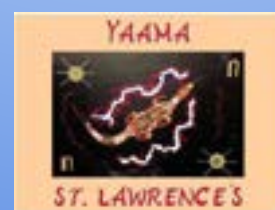

Maggie – she is loving and never gives up

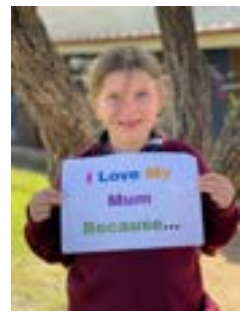

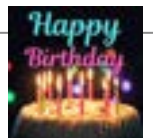
